First-Line Supervisors of Production & Operating Workers

A Day in the Life

First-line Supervisors oversee all the production and operating workers. They enforce rules and regulation. They record operational and production data. They enforce safety and sanitation regulations. They keep records of employees' attendance and hours worked.

They study blueprints and other instruction to determine how to set up equipment. They read and analyze charts, work orders, production schedules and other records and reports to determine production requirements and to evaluative current production estimates and outputs. They plan and establish work schedules, assignments, and production sequences to meet productions goals.

They observe work and monitor gauges, dials, and other indicators to ensure that operators conform to production or processing standards. They calculate materials, equipment, or labor requirements for production. They advise others on ways to improve processes and productions. They perform human resources activities and directly supervise workers.

How do I get into this top job?

This job requires a postsecondary non-degree award. While the job does not list on-the-job training as required you will likely need up to 5 years experience. If you do not have the experience required, you might have to start as a Production and Operating Worker first. If you are low income, ask your job coach, career counselor, training program, or workforce development specialist about assisting you with your training expenses. It might be free!
