A Day in the Life

Team assemblers work as part of a team having responsibility for assembling an entire product or component of a product. They can perform all the tasks conducted by the team in the assembly process or rotate through all of them, rather than being assigned to a specific team on a permanent basis. They perform quality checks on products and parts. They review work orders and blueprints to ensure work is performed according to specifications.

They may participate in making management decisions affecting the work. It includes team leaders work as part of the team. They determine work assignments and procedures. Supervise assemblers and train employees on job procedures. They shovel, sweep, or otherwise clean work areas. Provide assistance in the production of wiring assemblies. Maintain production equipment and machinery. They complete production reports to communicate team production level to management. They operate machinery and heavy equipment, such as forklifts.

How do I get into this top job?

This job requires a high school diploma or the equivalent. Once you have graduated you will need about six months of on-the-job training to do the job. Training programs may be expensive, but you might not have to pay for all of it yourself. If you are low income, ask your job coach, career counselor, training program, or workforce development specialist about assisting you with your training expenses. It might be free!
