A Day in the Life

Computer Systems Analysts analyze science, engineering, business, and other data processing problems to develop and implement solutions to complex applications problems, system administration issues, or network concerns. They perform systems management and integration functions, improve existing computer systems, and review computer system capabilities, workflow, and schedule limitations. They may analyze or recommend commercially available software.

Analysts coordinate software or hardware installation. Monitor computer system performance to ensure proper operation. Test software. Troubleshoot issues with computer applications or systems. Modify software programs to improve performance. Apply information technology to solve business or other applied problems. Write computer programming code. Analyze data to identify or resolve operational problems. Manage information technology projects or system activities. Supervise information technology personnel. Configure computer networks. Develop testing routines or procedures. Design integrated computer systems. Identify information technology project resource requirements. Collect data about customer needs.

How do I get into this top job?

You need a Bachelor's Degree to do this job. You might need additional licensing as well. Training programs and tests may be expensive, but you might not have to pay for all of it yourself. If you are low income, ask your job coach, career counselor, training program, or workforce development specialist about assisting you with your training expenses. It might be free!
