### A Day in the Life

Software Quality Assurance Analysts and Testers develop and execute software tests to identify software problems and their causes. They test system modifications to prepare for implementation. Document software and application defects using a bug tracking system and report defects to software or web developers. They create and maintain databases of known defects. They may participate in software design reviews to provide input on functional requirements, operational characteristics, product designs, and schedules. They develop testing routines or procedures. They compile technical information or documentation. They document operational activities.

Analysts and Testers create databases to store electronic data. They install computer software. They develop performance metrics or standards related to information technology. They provide customer service to clients or users. They analyze data to identify trends or relationships among variables. Read documents to gather technical information. They evaluate utility of software or hardware technologies. They collaborate with others to resolve information technology issues.

### How do I get into this top job?

You need a Bachelor's Degree to do this job. You might need additional licensing as well. Training programs and tests may be expensive, but you might not have to pay for all of it yourself. If you are low income, ask your job coach, career counselor, training program, or workforce development specialist about assisting you with your training expenses. It might be free!
