### A Day in the Life

A Logistician is the person that coordinates all parts of a logistics or other business operations. It is this person's job to make sure everything runs smoothly. They must maintain and develop positive business relationships with a customer's key personnel involved in, or directly relevant to, a logistics activity. They must develop an understanding of customers' needs and take actions to ensure that such needs are met.

The Logistician will develop proposals that include documentation for estimates. They manage subcontractor activities, reviewing proposals, developing performance specifications, and serving as liaisons between subcontractors and organizations. They review logistics performance with customers against targets, benchmarks, and service agreements. They collaborate with other departments as necessary to meet customer requirements, to take advantage of sales opportunities or, in the case of shortages, to minimize negative impacts on a business. They will report project plans, progress, and results and protect and control proprietary materials. They will stay informed of logistics technology advances and apply appropriate technology to improve logistics processes.

### How do I get into this top job?

This job requires a Bachelor's college degree, so you have some serious prep time ahead of you. It might be expensive, but you might not have to pay for all of it yourself. If you are low income, ask your job coach, career counselor, training program, or workforce development specialist about assisting you with your training expenses. It might be free!
