A Day in the Life

Helpers, Brickmasons, Blockmasons, Stonemasons, and Tile and Marble Setters plan, direct, or coordinate, usually through subordinate supervisory personnel, activities concerned with the construction and maintenance of structures, facilities, and systems. They participate in the conceptual development of a construction project and oversee its organization, scheduling, budgeting, and implementation. They include managers in specialized construction fields, such as carpentry or plumbing.

They mix substances or compounds needed for work activities. They assemble temporary equipment or structures and cut tile, stone, or other masonry materials. They assist skilled construction or extraction personnel. They determine operational procedures. They move construction or extraction materials to locations where they are needed. They clean surfaces in preparation for work activities. They maintain construction tools or equipment. They operate cranes, hoists, or other moving or lifting equipment and remove excess materials from finished construction projects. They apply sealants or other protective coatings.

How do I get into this top job?

This job has no formal education requirements but you will need about one month of on-the-job training to do the job. Training programs may be expensive, but you might not have to pay for all of it yourself. If you are low income, ask your job coach, career counselor, training program, or workforce development specialist about assisting you with your training expenses. It might be free!

What makes this a Top Job?

This is a good entry level position for someone without a degree. The Georgia Dept. of Labor estimates there will be 10 openings statewide per year through 2026. The pay is low, but it will get you in the door while you work on your education and skills.
