A Day in the Life

Helpers - Pipelayers, Plumbers, Pipefitters, and Steam fitters help plumbers, pipefitters, steamfitters, or pipelayers by performing duties requiring less skill. Their duties include using, supplying, or holding materials or tools, and cleaning work area and equipment.

Helpers install plumbing or piping. They cut metal components for installation and maintain plumbing structures or fixtures. They cut openings in existing structures. They drill holes in construction materials. They measure materials or objects for installation or assembly. They assist skilled construction or extraction personnel. They assemble products or production equipment.

They move construction or extraction materials to locations where they are needed. They install building fixtures. They order construction or extraction materials or equipment. They select construction materials. They dig holes or trenches. They remove worn, damaged or outdated materials from work areas. They clean equipment or facilities.

How do I get into this top job?

This job requires a high school diploma or the equivalent. You will also need about one month of on-the-job training. Training programs may be expensive, but you might not have to pay for all of it yourself. If you are low income, ask your job coach, career counselor, training program, or workforce development specialist about assisting you with your training expenses. It might be free!
